For his selfless service, leadership, research, and dedication to preserving the rich history of the Society and the field of military psychology.

Dr. Gade is a Past-President of the Society and has served in many roles in Division 19 over the last 40+ years. A tireless advocate and contributor to the science and research of the Society, his current research is in the history of military psychology. He also serves on the editorial board for the journal *Military Psychology* and is the editor for the *Spotlight on History* column in *The Military Psychologist*, the *Society for Military Psychology Newsletter*. Dr. Gade is an APA fellow and serves as the Society's historian and archivist. He received the Society's Charles S. Gersoni award for outstanding contributions to military psychology.

Dr. Gade is a U.S. Air Force veteran. He served as a senior research psychologist and the Chief of the Basic Research Unit for the U.S. Army Research Institute for the Behavioral and Social Sciences (ARI), where he developed and led ARI's intramural and extramural basic research programs for over 10 years. He is currently a Research Professor in the Organizational Sciences and Communications Department at the George Washington University and a senior research fellow at ARI.
