Presents this 2019 Presidential Citation to *Colonel (Retired) Sally Harvey, PhD*

For her leadership, steadfast dedication, and contributions to the fields of military and operational psychology, and to the Society for Military Psychology.

Prior to her positions of leadership within the Division, Dr. Harvey spent over 27 years serving in the United States Army. As a military psychologist, Dr. Harvey worked in both clinical and operational spheres, holding numerous positions of authority. There is no doubt that these experiences contributed greatly to her ability to lead with exceptional ease during her time in the Division. She has held positions as the President of the Society and as one of our representatives on the APA Council of Representatives.

Dr. Harvey's faithful support of the Division and our members has been present from the first release of the Hoffman Report, and has remained steady during each step of the repercussions that followed. Dr. Harvey was the lead author of the Division 19 Task Force Report that addressed the statements made in the APA's Independent Report. She also championed initiatives as a Division representative to the APA Council of Representatives to regain lost ground for psychologists supporting national security interrogations and providing mental health support to detainees.

Dr. Harvey has remained a strong voice of leadership for our Society on topics of ethics and the work of psychologists as they support national security and defense. Dr. Harvey has debated national figures in the field of peace psychology and social justice movements, provided numerous interviews and authored articles in support of military and national security psychologists, and recently co-edited an important book on the role of psychologists in national security, defense, and public safety. All this time she has been a mentor to students and ECPs in the Division, and most recently, for the Society Leadership Program.

For her exceptional leadership in the Society and work in ensuring psychologists' support of national security and defense, I, Stephen Bowles, present the Society for Military Psychology Presidential Citation to Dr. Sally Harvey.
