Captain Mathew McCauley, PsyD, AFBPS

For his exceptional leadership, service, and international clinical and research contributions in advancing the science and practice of military psychology.

Dr. McCauley is a Consultant Clinical Psychologist with over 15 years of service in military healthcare. A Captain in the Medical Corps, Army Reserve, he is also an Assistant Professor of Clinical Psychology at Trinity College, University of Dublin. In addition to his longstanding commitment to providing psychological services to defense personnel, Dr. McCauley has made significant research contributions to the field of military psychology over the past two years. He initiated, recruited, and led a team of over thirty authors in the production of a special edition of the Journal of the Royal Army Medical Corps, which focuses on the history, scope, and delivery of military psychology in the UK Armed Forces. Involving 21 papers, the publication offers a comprehensive coverage of the background to the discipline in the UK, along with specialist sections on clinical, research, and industrial/organizational military psychology.

This important addition to the military psychology literature addresses subjects such as leadership and command liaison, clinical assessment and treatment, occupational health, neuropsychology, clinical health and rehabilitation psychology, psychological trauma, psychosexual interventions, alcohol treatment programs, psychological resiliency, screening and selection, cognitive functioning and stress on operations, psychological contributions to officer training, and psychological research processes and systems across the deployment cycle. Dr. McCauley's work has received recognition in the UK military medical community. His ground-breaking achievement serves as an outstanding resource for healthcare professionals, scientists, academics and leaders across the military. It also raises the public profile of British military psychology in the UK and internationally.

For his international clinical and research contributions in the field of military psychology through steadfast leadership and service, I, Stephen V. Bowles, take great pleasure in presenting the Society for Military Psychology Presidential Citation to Dr. Mathew McCauley.
