

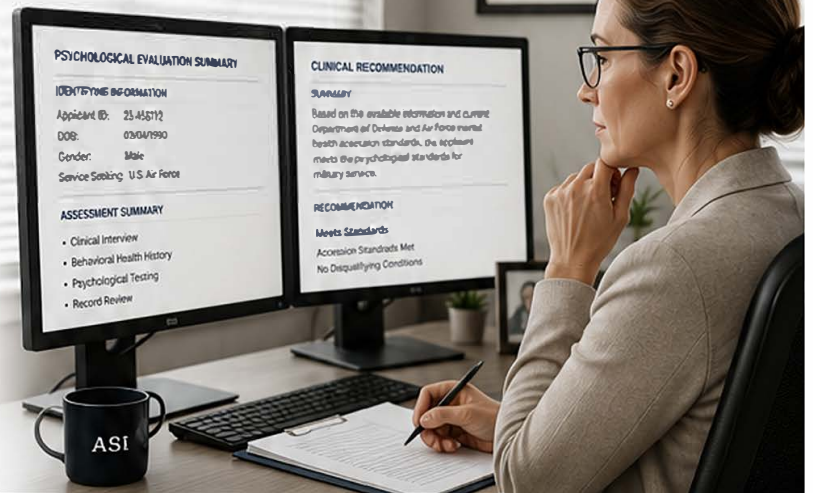

THE MISSION

Support the Headquarters Air Force Accessions Center by conducting psychological evaluations, reviewing behavioral health documentation, and providing evidence-based clinical recommendations that help determine medical qualification for military service. Your expertise directly contributes to ensuring the Air Force maintains a medically ready and resilient force.

Unlike traditional outpatient practice, this role focuses on assessment rather than ongoing therapy, allowing you to apply your military experience in a structured, mission-driven environment.



WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Conduct psychological evaluations supporting accession determinations.
- Review behavioral health and psychological treatment records.
- Conduct telehealth interviews, when required.
- Develop concise clinical summaries and evidence-based recommendations.
- Apply DoD and Air Force mental health accession standards.
- Collaborate with Flight Surgeons, Aerospace Medical Standards Specialists, and multidisciplinary medical teams.
- Participate in quality assurance and policy implementation.
- Maintain complete and accurate documentation in secure systems.



REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Doctoral degree (Ph.D. or Psy.D.) in Psychology.
- Current unrestricted psychology license.
- Minimum three (3) years serving as a Military Biomedical Science Corps Officer/Psychologist within the past fifteen (15) years.
- Experience conducting military psychological evaluations.
- Experience applying military medical standards.
- Experience supporting accession or special duty evaluations.
